She received her Master of Music Education degree from Florida State University and received a Bachelors of Music degree from James Madison University. Mrs. Glomb has over twenty years of public school and private studio teaching experience at every level throughout Fairfax County, Loudoun County, Prince William County in Virginia and Orange County, Florida.

Mrs. Glomb's groups have performed at invitational performances including the White House, The Kennedy Center and with the Washington Bach Consort. In addition, Mrs. Glomb's ensembles have performed multiple times at the Virginia Music Educator's Association Conference and was recently featured on Channel 7 news show "Good Morning Washington." Mrs. Glomb has given conference

presentations at the Florida Music Educators Association Conference in Tampa, Florida and the American Choral Directors Association in Philadelphia, PA.

Mrs. Glomb has held District XI Chairperson for Choral Directors in the Fairfax County Public Schools and has been recognized as an "Emerging Leader" of the Virginia Choral Directors Association. Mrs. Glomb has served as a clinician for middle and high school honor choirs, as well as a festival adjudicator, throughout the state of Florida, Virginia, and Maryland. She is currently the Soprano/Alto Repertoire and Resource Chair for Virginia ACDA and is the newly appointed Jr. High/Middle School Repertoire and Resource chair for Southern ACDA. She is a member of NAFME, VMEA, ACDA and SAI.



Millie Turek, Accompanist

Millie Lanier Turek has been a high school and middle school choral director in public and private schools in the Atlanta area for the past 41 years. She is currently the Associate Music Director, accompanist, and instructor for the choirs of the Atlanta Young Singers. Ms. Turek has an undergraduate degree in music education from Florida State University, Masters of Music from Georgia State University, and Kodaly Certification from Westminster Choir College of Rider University.

She is a past Georgia state president of the American Choral Directors Association and is an active member of the Georgia Music Educators Association. Throughout her career she has served as clinician, accompanist, and adjudicator for numerous all-state choirs, honor choruses, and choral festivals in the Southeast. Choruses under her direction have performed numerous times at the GMEA State In-service, ACDA Southern Division and ACDA National Conferences. In 2010, the Sandy Creek High School Select Mixed Chorus under her direction was one of 12 choirs in the nation invited to participate in the first Chanticleer National Youth Choral Festival in San Francisco. As accompanist, she has toured with the AYS choirs in international competitions in Canada, Europe, and South Africa and played at performances honoring the 100th birthday of Nelson Mandela and Robert Shaw.

Ms. Grant is currently the Choral Director at Northwestern Middle School in Milton, Georgia where she and the NMS Music Department received the Georgia Music Educators Association Program of the Year Award in 2022. She came to Northwestern in 2012 from New York City where she lived and worked as a freelance musician and music teacher. Prior to her time in New York, Ms. Grant taught Choral Music at Haynes Bridge Middle School and Centennial High School as well as private voice and piano at The Peggy Still School of Music. She has also taught in Fayette County and Lawton, Oklahoma. Ms. Grant holds a master's degree in Music Education from the University of

Georgia where she also completed her undergraduate work after attending Shorter College for 2 years. In addition to teaching Choral Music, Ms. Grant gives solo performances, accompanies, teaches private voice and piano, leads professional development for Secondary Choral Teachers and serves as a guest conductor for honor choirs around the Southeast. In addition to her teaching duties at Northwestern, Ms. Grant is the Fulton County Schools Fine Arts Support Teacher for Middle School Chorus.
